Bow Valley High School Takes Play Online

- Bow Valley High School teacher Adrienne Fossheim and performing arts students presented a Student Showcase to the Board of Trustees (the Board) highlighting their Virtual Shakespeare in the Park production.
- Due to the pandemic, the performing arts program had to adapt in order to deliver this year's production. While the play was initially planned as an outdoor performance, it shifted after COVID-19 restrictions were strengthened. Instead, the play was filmed in Bow Valley's gym and posted to YouTube.
- The cast and crew outlined how they developed the show for an outdoor space, then adjusted to perform, film and upload the play to the internet.

Board Sets Meeting Dates for Upcoming School Year

- The Board approved a meeting schedule for the 2021/22 school year, establishing meeting dates on the first and third Thursdays of most months, with some adjustments due to the trustee election, holiday and specific Alberta Education requirements.

Tie Breaking Process Added to Board Operations Policy

- The Board approved an updated version of Policy 7 – Board Operations. A tie breaking process to decide elected and appointed positions was added to the policy, and the election of the Board Chair and Vice-Chair was clarified.

Board Updates Recruitment and Selection of Personnel Policy

- The Board approved changes to Policy 16 – Recruitment and Selection of Personnel. The policy was updated to reflect current practice and clarify language. References to the *Education Act* were also updated.
